## CONTACT DAYCARE CENTERS

- Call each center to inquire about availability and schedule a visit
- Ask about their program, hours, fees, and enrollment process
- Inquire about their experience with twins and if they have experience caring for multiples
- Based on the information you have been given, narrow down your list to your top daycare centers

## VISIT YOUR TOP DAYCARE CENTERS

- Schedule visits to the daycare centers on your shortlist
- Observe the cleanliness and organization of the facility
- Check the safety measures in place, such as childproofing, secure doors, and fenced play areas
- Evaluate the interaction between staff and children, including how they handle conflicts and discipline

## ASK QUESTIONS

- Inquire about the staff-to-child ratio and the qualifications of the caregivers
- Ask about the availability of two spots, sibling discounts and if there is a fee for holding spots
- Ask about the daily schedule and activities provided for the children
- Discuss the center's policies on feeding, napping, and handling medical emergencies
- Inquire about their communication with parents, including daily reports and updates
- Ask about the center's policies on sick children, vaccinations, and medication administration

## YOUR BUDGET AND NEEDS

- Compare the costs of different daycare centers
- Determine if the center's location, hours, and services meet your needs

## REVIEW CONTRACTS AND POLICIES

Review the center's policies on holidays, vacations, and sick days

Ask about the center's policies on sick children, vaccinations, and medication administration

## TRUST YOUR INSTINCTS

Pay attention to your gut feeling about each daycare center

Choose a daycare where you feel comfortable and confident leaving your twins
